Saturday, Jun 8

In-transit from home country. Airport pick-up upon arrival. Check into a hotel, have dinner and rest.

Sunday, Jun 9

Buenos Aires, Queen of La Plata

Cultural capital of South America, Buenos Aires is a city that deftly combines Latin passion with European majesty and remains one of the largest cities on the continent. It is the gateway to the rest of the country and its hidden gems.

8:00am: Breakfast

10:30am: Free time. You may explore the surrounding area on your own.

12:00pm: Lunch. Head off to the airport.

3:30pm: Fly to Foz do Iguacu (7hrs) in Brazil.

Foz do Iguacu, the land of waterfalls

The modern, fast-paced city is home to the wondrous and world-famous Iguazu Falls, which royally divide Brazil and Argentina.

11:00pm: Check into a hotel and rest.

Monday, Jun 10

7:00am: Breakfast

9:00am: Drive to Iguazú National Park to witness the majestic beauty of 275 waterfalls that make up stunning Iguassu Falls, sitting on the border of Brazil and Argentina.

10:30am: Start the guided tour from the Lower Circuit in Iguazu National Park on the Argentina side. Follow a trail that affords majestic views of smaller falls like Carlos Bozzetti Waterfall. Continue to the Upper Circuit at the top of the waterfalls and catch panoramic views of the area on both sides of the border. Explore the area on your own.

5:00pm: Return to the hotel.

6:30pm: Dinner and retire for the night.

Tuesday, Jun 11

Foz do Iguacu

9:00am: Cross the border to Iguassu Falls on the Brazil side. Enter Iguacu National Park.

11:00am: Enter Iguacu National Park and experience first-hand the grandeur of Devil's Throat waterfall. Take a boat-ride. Have packed lunch in between.

3:30pm: Head back to the hotel. Enjoy free time.

6:30pm: Have dinner. Rest.

Wednesday, Jun 12

Foz do Iguacu

7:00am: Breakfast

10:00am: Free time followed by a light, early lunch before heading off to the airport.

1:30pm: Fly back to Buenos Aires (10 hours 40 mins)

12:00 am: Head off to the hotel and rest.



Thursday, Jun 13

Buenos Aires

7:00am: Breakfast

10:00am: Drive to Estancia Santa Susana, a ranch in Los Cardeles to witness first-hand the traditional customs of Argentine ranch life.

12:00pm: After a warm welcome at the ranch house, take a guided tour of Santa Susana's grounds and its local sites of interest. Interact with local people and learn about the history of the ranch. Meet the friendly gauchos — talented wranglers and horsemen. Explore the surrounding farmland on horseback. Alternatively, hop aboard a horse-drawn carriage for a ride through the farmland. Upon return to the ranch, settle in at a rustic banquet table for a delicious, authentic lunch. Enjoy a performance of traditional folk music and dancing as well as a boleadoras show where gauchos perform impressive stunts of weapon throwing.

6:30pm: Drive back to the hotel.

8:00pm: Dinner and return to the hotel.

Friday, Jun 14

Buenos Aires

7:00am: Breakfast

9:00am: Take a guided tour of Plaza de Mayo, home to Casa Rosada (the government house) followed by a trip to San Telmo, the city's oldest barrio and witness random tango performances on the street.

12:30pm: Lunch-break

2:30pm: Stop over at the neighborhood of the vibrant La Boca, now a hub for the city's budding artists. Take a trip to Palermo, the city's largest neighborhood, followed by the glitzy Recoleta area. Visit the grave of Eva Perón, the world-famous former first lady of Argentina.

5:30pm: Take a tango lesson.

8:00pm: Dinner and return to the hotel.

Saturday, Jun 15

Buenos Aires

7:00am: Breakfast

9:00am: Take a guided tour of Colon Theatre, one of the world's most famous opera houses.

11:30am: Drive to Tigre Delta, a suburb built around the swampy land and meandering waterways that empty from the Rio Paraná into the Rio de la Plata.

1:00pm: Lunch-break

3:00pm: Tour Puerto de Frutos, a vibrant port that connects island dwellers to the mainland. Enjoy the laid-back waterside ambience of Tigre's Paseo Victoria dotted with stately mansions, museums and rowing clubs. If time permits, visit one of several local museums, including the Tigre Art Museum, the Naval Museum and Museum of Mate.

6:30pm: Dinner

8:30pm: Drive back to the hotel and rest.

Sunday, Jun 16

Fly back home from Buenos Aires.
